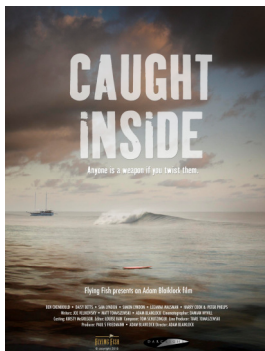


Opening Night Film — Dark Fall, Monday, December 27th, 8.00pm start (Australian Premiere)

Caught Inside, Wednesday December 29th, 8.00pm start (Special Preview Screening)

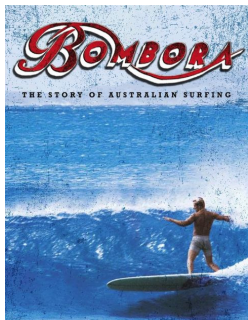
